1) Shreya enlarged the size of a rectangle to a width of 5.5 in . What is the new height if it was originally 1.1 in wide and 6.8 in tall?
2) The money used in Peru is called the Nuevo Sole. The exchange rate is $\$ 8.80$ for 1 Nuevo Sole. Find how many dollars you would receive if you exchanged 32.4 Nuevos Soles.
3) Shanice took a trip to Tajikistan. Upon leaving she decided to convert all of her Somoni back into dollars. How many dollars did she receive if she exchanged 43.5 Somoni at a rate of $\$ 1$ for every 3.2 Somoni?
4) Arjun reduced the size of a photo to a width of 1 in . What is the new height if it was originally 32.9 in tall and 7 in wide?
5) The currency in Tajikistan is the Somoni. The exchange rate is approximately 1 Somoni for every $\$ 9.70$. At this rate, how many Somoni would you get if you exchanged $\$ 436.60$ ?
6) Trevon was planning a trip to the United Arab Emirates. Before going, he did some research and learned that the exchange rate is $\$ 6.90=1$ Dirham. How many Dirhams would he get if he exchanged $\$ 264.70$ ?
7) One bunch of fennel costs $\$ 2.30$. How many bunches can you buy for $\$ 39.10$ ?
8) Five bulbs of elephant garlic cost $\$ 9.95$. How many bulbs can you buy for $\$ 49.75$ ?

15) Kayla took a trip to the United Arab Emirates. Upon leaving she decided to convert all of her Dirhams back into dollars. How many dollars did she receive if she exchanged 31.2 Dirhams at a rate of $\$ 8.40$ to 1 Dirham?
